Working with funding provided by the Government of Alberta, Edmonton Public Schools plans and prioritizes its capital needs carefully to meet the needs of students today and into the future.

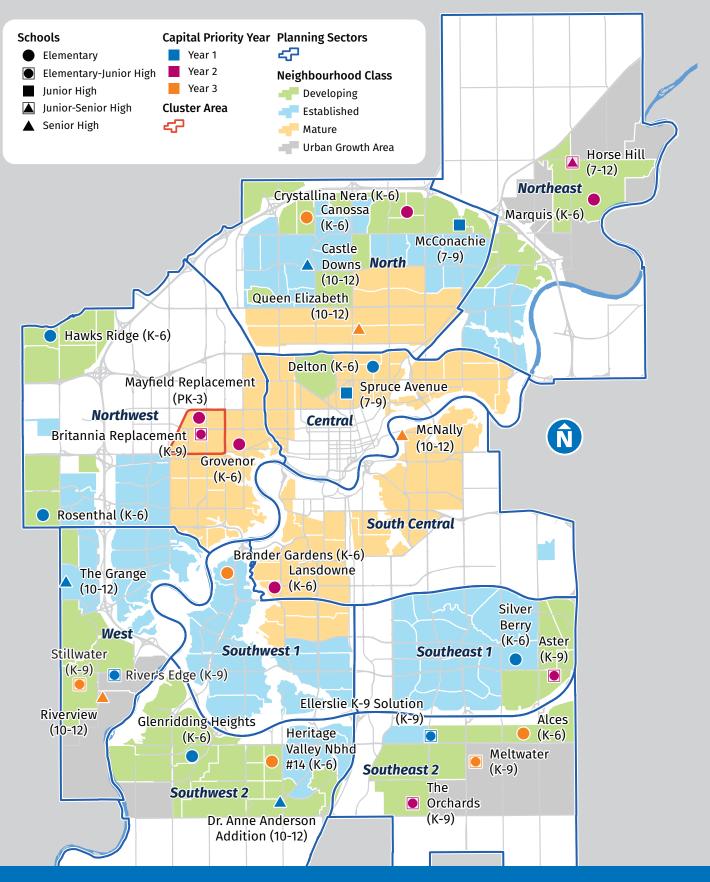
