



Banff National Park is located in the province of Alberta in the Canadian Rocky Mountains. It is situated 128 km (80 miles) west of Calgary, 401 km (250 miles) southwest of Edmonton and 850 km (500 mi) northeast of Vancouver.

Important Messages

- An alcohol and cannabis ban in effect during your stay. Possession and consumption of alcohol or cannabis is prohibited from Friday June 30, 2023 to Monday July 3, 2023.
- Note: This is not a valid camping permit and all guests must register at the campground kiosk to obtain their camping permit before entering the campground. To assist our staff in registering you, please present your booking number to Park staff when you check-in at the park.
- Campfires and the consumption of alcohol or cannabis are not permitted between 11:00pm and 7:00am daily.
- Quiet hours, alcohol and cannabis restrictions in effect year round, please visit Banff National Park camping website for more information http://www.pc.gc.ca/en/pn-np/ab/banff/activ/camping/rules-regles
 - Campfires: Trailer Court: No open fires.
 - Maximum Persons per Site: 6 people.
 - Two Jack Lakeside walk-in sites: campsites are small and the recommended maximum group size is 4 people, maximum 1 tent, maximum 1 vehicle.
 - Maximum Vehicles per Site (exception Two Jack Lakeside): 2 vehicles: maximum 1 wheeled camping unit and 1 regular vehicle. We do not permit 2 wheeled camping units on the same site.
 - Maximum Camping Units per Site (exception Two Jack Lakeside): 2 tents or 1 RV/camper and 1 tent.
- If you choose to cancel or make any changes to your reservation after it is confirmed, a non-refundable change or cancellation fee will be applied for each transaction.
- Parks Canada charges user fees at national parks to support quality visitor services and facilities. Please note that you will be required to pay daily entrance fees when you arrive for your visit and these entrance fees are not included in the amount that you will pay today.


